



DAILY OPERATIONAL INFORMATION UPDATE

MANNVILLE PRODUCED WATER PIPELINE BREAK

August 18, 2018

This operational update will be provided daily until this incident is concluded.

Work accomplished in the past 24 hours

- Hauled 500 m³ of contaminated soil to landfill from the containment areas;
- Excavated 650 m³ of contaminated soil into the containment areas;
- Nearing the completion of excavating the contaminated materials into the containment cells;
- 3rd party engineering firm is analyzing the pipeline failure;
- Continue to monitor water collecting in bell holes and sending for disposal as appropriate. No additional free fluids recovered; and
- Submitted Interim (Short term) Pipeline and Failure and Release Prevention Plan to the AER.

Work forecast for next 24 hours

- Prepping pipeline trench and right of way for new installation of high and low pressure pipeline, riser and new borehole as per AER approval;
- 3rd party engineering firm is analyzing the pipeline failure; and
- Continue to monitor water collecting in bell holes and sending for disposal as appropriate.
